# **Opening the Sealed Scroll**

### Revelation 6:1-8

## I. <u>Introduction:</u>

#### A. Context

- **1.** In chapter 5 Jesus took possession of a 7-sealed scroll from the Father's hand because He is the only one qualified or worthy to receive it.
- **2.** A strong angel had asked for anyone worthy to step forward and receive the scroll.
- **3.** Jesus, Lion of Judah, root of David, omnipotent & omniscient Lamb, is only 1worthy.
- **4.** Scroll: contains God's plan for the conclusion of history including tribulation period.

### B. The tribulation

- 1. The tribulation is 7-year period when God pours out His judgment on a wicked world.
- **2.** It ends with the return of Jesus to establish His kingdom on the earth.
- 3. It's the last 7 years of human history as we know it. It's divided into two 3½ year parts.

#### a. – First half

- i. The first 3½ years of the tribulation will be marked by a false peace.
- ii. The church's rapture will cause confusion & trepidation around the world.
- **iii**. A leader will step forward seeming to have all the answers, but this person is the antichrist, the one who will lead in the world-wide rebellion against God.

#### **b.** – Second half.

- i. The entire 7-year period is referred to in the Bible as the tribulation; however, it's the last 3½ years that are referred to as the Great Tribulation.
- ii. The last 3½ years are called the time of Jacob's trouble or the Day of the Lord.
- iii. Majority of judgments described in Chapters 6-18 take place in the last ½ of the tribulation. The only exception being the first of the seal judgments.

# II. Opening the scroll (Revelation 6:1-2)

• Jesus breaks the seals & opens scroll He received from the Father. Each of the 1<sup>st</sup> four seals introduces a horseman often referred to as the 4 horseman of the apocalypse.

## A. The first seal

- **1.** As Jesus opened 1<sup>st</sup> seal, 1 of the four living creatures invited John to come and see.
- **2.** These living creatures are actively involved in the plan of God.

#### B. White horse

- *The first of the four horses is white.*
- White represents the false peace brokered by antichrist in the first half of the tribulation.

#### 1. - Bow with no arrows

- **a.** The peace of the first half of the tribulation will be brokered without war.
- **b.** The empty bow represents the threat of war. If antichrist's kingdom were established by war, the rider would most likely have been seen with a sword.

#### 2 - Crown

- **a.** A rider wears a victor's crown, a *stephanos*. This represents a crown that was won.
- **b**. By contrast, crown Jesus wears is a *diadema*, crown of royalty. It's His right as King

# III. The Second Seal (Revelation 6:3-4)

#### A. Red horse

- 1. The brokered peace only lasts  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years, then worldwide war will break out.
- **2.** This war will be fought for the same reasons men fight today.
- **3.** Antichrist will seek to extend his empire & control resources in middle east, the oil.
- **4.** The antichrist is going to proclaim himself to be god and demand people worship him.
- **5.** Muslim nations & nations of the far east will resist & fight him.
- **6.** He'll break his treaty with Israel & turn on them. Israel will be caught in the middle & suffer terribly in the last ½ of the tribulation. The world will be thrown into world war.

# IV. The Third Seal (Revelation 6:5-6)

#### A. Black horse

- 1. The black horse represents death by famine. A natural side effect of war is famine.
- 2. Rather than farming, nations become war machines & able-bodied men are out fighting
- **3.** There will be severe food shortages in the last half of the tribulation.
- **4.** Many will die in the warfare. Just as many will die of starvation.

## 5. – A day's wages

- a. A denarius was equivalent to a day's wages. Person has to work all day for 1 meal.
- **b**. Barley was typically used to feed the animals.

## 6. – Oil and wine

- **a.** Oil and wine represent luxuries among the rich who will not suffer immediately.
- **b.** But eventually the famine will impact everyone.

# V. <u>The Fourth Seal</u> (Revelation 6:7-8)

## A. The pale or ashen horse

- 1. Along with famine, war brings disease and the wild beasts.
- **2.** We are intimately familiar with how a pandemic can disrupt life.
- **3.** War exacerbates disease because of a lack of medicine and often unsanitary conditions.

## B. One fourth of earth's population

- 1. One fourth of the earth's population will die by war, famine, and disease.
- **2.** 2018 earth's population was 7.6 billion. If 1.6 billion are saved, then 6 billion enters tribulation and 1/4<sup>th</sup> of 6 billion is 1.5 billion. A lot of people dying from warfare, etc...

## C. Verified by prophesy

• The things John saw in these first four opened seals are verified by prophesy.

## 1. – Daniel (Daniel 9:27)

- **a.** This verse speaks of the antichrist. The "week" mentioned is the tribulation period.
- **b.** Daniel speaks of those 7 years as a week.
- **c.** The antichrist will make a covenant with many, the time of false peace.
- **d.** Then  $\frac{1}{2}$  through the week,  $\frac{3}{2}$  year mark, he'll break the covenant & there'll be war.

### 2. – Jesus (Matthew 24-25)-the Olivet Discourse.

- a. Jesus on the Mount of Olives told His disciples what would happen in the end times
- **b.** Jesus foretold how antichrist will break the covenant with Israel halfway through the tribulation. (**Matthew 24:15-22**) Antichrist will desecrate the temple in Jerusalem.
- c. The abomination of desolation is when antichrist demands that everyone worship him
- d. Jesus said, 1. Unlike anything world's ever seen 2. All'd die if God didn't cut it short

## 3. – Apostle Paul (1 Thessalonians 5:3-6)

- a. When world thinks under antichrist's leadership is peace, destruction suddenly comes
- **b.** One person can bring lasting peace to this world and His name is Jesus Christ.
- **c.** Not in Darkness: The apostle Paul said we are not in darkness; we are in the light.
