# **Those Saved During the Tribulation**

#### Revelation 7:1-12

# I. <u>Introduction:</u>

## A. Introduction & Context

- 1. The length of the tribulation
  - **a.** The tribulation period will be 7 years divided into two 3and 1/2-year periods.
  - **b.** The first half will be marked by a false peace, brokered by the antichrist.
  - **c.** 2<sup>nd</sup> half will be marked by terrible judgment & suffering for all who'll be on earth.

## **2.** – Pretribulation rapture

- **a.** The Bible clearly teaches a pretribulation rapture of the church.
- **b.** Jesus appears & calls His church out of this world before His judgment falls.
- 3. Some will be saved.
  - **a.** Even during this time of God's judgment on a wicked and sinful world, His grace will still be at work. Vast multitude of people will be saved during 7-year tribulation
  - b. Warning: Those who reject God today will be deceived by antichrist& believe his lie

### **B.** Parenthetical

- **1.** Chapter 7 is a parenthetical chapter meaning it doesn't advance the chronological flow of events. It is like a pause in the action.
- **2.** The pause is to address a matter of importance and fill in the details.
- **3.** At the end of chapter 6 a question and statement were made. (**Revelation 6:17**)
- **4.** The answer is no one would be able to stand apart from the grace of God.

# II. The Angels Seen (Revelation 7:1-3)

## A. Four angels

- 1. These 4 angels are standing on the 4 corners of the earth: north, south, east, and west.
- 2. They're commanded to withhold the wind for it blows not on the earth, sea, or any tree
- **3.** The wind stands for the judgment announced in chapter 6.
- **4.** These four angels are commanded to withhold the judgment.

#### B. Another angel

- 1. Then another angel ascends from the east who possesses the seal of God.
- **2.** He identified the reason for judgment to be temporarily withheld.
- 3. There's a group of saints belonging to God to be marked before judgment begins.
- **4.** They are to be sealed and receive a mark in their forehead.

#### C. Reasons for the mark:

- 1. <u>Indicates ownership</u>
  - **a.** God will put His seal upon these saints so the whole world will know they're His.
  - **b.** They will stand out in the tribulation as God's redeemed.
  - **c.** Application: The world should be able to see that we belong to Jesus.
  - d. The moment of salvation we were sealed by the Holy Spirit's power (Eph. 1:13-14).
  - **e.** Fact that we belong to God is evidenced by the Holy Spirit's presence in our lives.

# $2. - \underline{Protection}$

- **a.** This 1<sup>st</sup> group of saved people in the tribulation will be protected from the antichrist.
- **b.** The seal of God upon these saints will keep them from harm.

- c. Antichrist will want to silence and kill them, but he will not be able to do so.
- **d.** Application: By the power of the Holy Spirit we're eternally secure in our salvation.

# III. First group is Jewish. (Revelation 7:4-8)

## A. The remnant of Israel

- 1. This first group of redeemed from out of the tribulation will be Jewish.
- 2. God will save and seal 12,000 Jews out of each tribe of Israel.
- **3.** There're 12 tribes of Israel thus there'll be 144,000 saved & sealed for His purpose.

#### B. Points to Consider

## 1. – Purpose of these 144,000 is twofold.

- (1) They will preach the Gospel.
  - a. They can't be harmed by the antichrist so they'll preach the Gospel unimpeded.
  - **b**. The church has been raptured and is in heaven, so in the darkest days of human history, these redeemed of Christ will be sharing the good news that Jesus saves.

## (2) Remnant of Israel

- **a.** There will be a generation of Jews who enter the millennial kingdom.
- **b.** These Jews will be the seed group who'll form the nation of Israel as Jesus sits on David's throne. The Jews of the Kingdom will accept Jesus as their Lord & King.
- **c.** Jesus will rule1,000-years on earth & Israel will be the greatest nation at that time.

## 2. – Literal interpretation

- a. To interpret this passage as an allegory opens the meaning to boundless imagination.
- **b.** The literal interpretation is the only one supported by the context of the passage.
- c. God will literally save and seal 144,000 Jews during the tribulation period.

#### 3. – Jehovah's Witnesses

- **a.** The Jehovah's witnesses believe that 144,000 people in the church age will be resurrected & become spiritual Israel in heaven, getting the number here.
- **b.** That's false interpretation& teaching, 144,000 are Jewish, shown by 12 tribes listed.

# IV. Multitude of others (Revelation 7:9-12)

## A. A great host before the throne

- 1. After seeing sealing of 144k Jews, John saw a great host standing before God's throne.
  - **a.** This host are those who were saved out of the tribulation, who believed on Jesus.
  - **b.** No doubt, they were martyred for their faith.

#### 2. – Wearing white robes

- **a.** These white robes signify their righteousness before God.
- b. Jesus forgave their sin when they believed on Him. They stand before God redeemed
- **c.** Application: The saved today appear before God as perfectly righteous in His Son.

#### 3. - Diversity

- **a.** John said there're people saved from among all nations, tribes, peoples, & tongues.
- **b.** God is no respecter of persons, He created all of us. (Galatians 3:26-28)
- **c.** Application to current events: Events remind us of man's sinfulness & brokenness.
- **d.** The Gospel message is the answer to what we see going on today.

## 4. – Praise and worship

a. The multitude joined angels, elders, & creatures around the throne to worship God.

# V. <u>Verified</u> (Revelation 7:13-17)

## A. Saved out of the tribulation

- **1.** This vast host of saints will be saved out of the tribulation.
- **2.** They will suffer and die for their profession of faith in Jesus.
