God Is Love

1 John 4:7-11

I. <u>Introduction:</u>

A. Context

- Satan has many false teachers in the world. Satan's desire is twofold:
 - 1. To keep the lost blinded in their sin
 - a. Satan does not want lost men and women to believe on Jesus and be saved.
 - 2. Harass those who are saved
 - a. Satan hates Jesus and therefore he hates all who belong to Jesus.
 - **b.** He wants to make them ineffective for kingdom of Christ, but they have practical victory over the attacks & deception of Satan by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- **B.** Love: There are two important things to remember about the love of God.
 - 1. It is God's nature
 - **a.** God is love is why we're saved. God's love is motive for everything He has done.
 - 2. The Greatest Evidence
 - **a.** Living out the love of God is the greatest evidence of salvation.
 - **b.** Holy Spirit producing God's love in hearts &lives is positive proof they're in Christ.
 - c. We are never more like God than when we love others as God loves.

II. Evidence of the New Birth (1 John 4:7-8)

- **A.** Everyone who loves: Everyone who loves like God gives evidence of two things.
 - 1. That we are born of God
 - **a.** Only way a person can love others unconditionally is to be a new creation in Christ.
 - **b.** Only way a person can love others sacrificially is through saving faith in Jesus.
 - c. Only way we can love others with God's love is for Holy Spirit to produce it in us.
 - **d.** Loving God &others w/ His kind of love is proof of salvation as evidenced by H. S.
 - 2. That we know God
 - **a.** This knowing God is more than just knowing about God.
 - **b.** Many people know about God for example the demons of hell know about God.
 - **c.** But when we know God by a personal saving faith in Jesus Christ, we know Him experientially which makes us new on the inside.
 - **d**. It is the new man, empowered by the Holy Spirit, that can love like God loves.

B. He who does not love.

- 1. He who does not have the Holy Spirit, producing the love of God in him, gives evidence that he really does not know God. (1 John 4:8a)
- **2.** Application: It is possible for a true believer in Christ to fail to love as God loves.
- 3. We fail in our responsibility to love others just as we fail in many other areas of life.
- **4.** When we fail to love God or others as we should, we are convicted, we confess our sin, & once again embrace the power of the Holy Spirit to love as we should.

C. God is Love (1 John 4:8)

- 1. "For God is love" is different from saying love is of God or comes from God.
- 2. This is a statement concerning the very nature of God. (1 John 1:5)
- **3.** Light and love are not attributes of God; they are who He is.
 - (1) God is light

- a. God's absolute purity, holiness, & righteousness are manifest in His nature as light
- **b.** Light is the opposite of darkness which is always associated w/ evilness, foulness, deception, and gloom. God's nature as light shines into a world of sin & darkness.
- **c.** God has shone the light of who He is in the world in the person of His Son, Jesus.
- **d**. Jesus is the light that lights the heart of every man. (**John 1:9**)
- e. Humanity: Of all creatures God created, mankind's only one created in His image
- **f.** Mankind is the only creature who can recognize the light of God and respond to it.
- (2) God is love: That God is love explains much of what is difficult to understand.
 - (a) It explains creation
 - i. God created because He is love.
 - ii. All of physical creation was created for man to have and enjoy.
 - **iii.** Because God is love He wanted to create creature upon which to lavish love **(b)** It explains free will
 - **i.** Unless love is a free choice, it's not love. God could've created world where people have no choice, but that would've made us nothing more than robots.
 - ii. God created us to be able to receive light & respond to His goodness w/ love.
 - (c) It explains redemption
 - i. God tolerates man's rebellion, hard heart & continual pursuit of wickedness.
 - ii. God continues to offer mercy & grace when man perpetually breaks His heart
 - **iii.** Because God is love He longs for us to be saved & to be restored to a right relationship with Him. God loves us & desires to have fellowship with us.

III. The Ultimate Demonstration of Love (1 John 4:9-10)

A. A Transcendent Expression of Love

- 1. Ultimate expression of God's love is giving of His only Son to die for us on the cross.
- 2. To "live through Him" means to have eternal life. He became the propitiation for sin
- 3. Word propitiation means satisfaction or payment. God declared sin would be punished.
- **4.** God's holiness demands sin be punished. If God punished us for our sin, all humanity would go to hell. Because God is also love, He made a way for both to be satisfied.
- **5.** God's justice was satisfied on the cross so we can enjoy the fullness of God's love.
- **6.** There is not greater expression of love than the death of Jesus on the cross of Calvary.

B. Reciprocated Love

- 1. All human love is the result of God's love & is patterned after God's love.
- **2.** God is the source of all true selfless love. We love God because He first loved us.

IV. Exhortation (1 John 4:11)

A. Since God is Love

- **1.** The word "if" has the meaning of "since." There is a conditional clause here.
- 2. Since God is love, proven by giving of His only Son, we're obligated to love 1 another.
- **3.** We are to love God, the brethren, & the lost selflessly. This kind of love has 3 results:
 - (1) God is glorified.
 - **a.** If we love God selflessly, then we'll obey Him. God's glorified when He's obeyed.
 - (2) Unity in the Body of Christ
 - **a**. Selfless love won't demand personal rights. Selfless love seeks the best for others, puts others ahead of self, builds up and edifies, & forgives all wrong.
 - (3) Evangelism among the lost
 - a. When the lost world sees the love of God in us, they will be drawn to that love.
 - **b.** We can't effectively share the Gospel with people whom we don't genuinely love.
