





















OBC Kids Camp 2023 - Camper Checklist





What to Bring to camp.....

-  Bible (Not on cell phone or tablet or e-reader). If you don't have one let Mrs. Kim know.
-  Any necessary prescription or allergy related medicines or OTC meds. If prescription, needs to be in RX bottle. If more than 1 type, please put in Ziploc bag and provide written instructions.
-  1 piece Swimsuit for girls (NO bikini's). Some campers bring 2 swimsuits/trunks.
-  Appropriate clothing - sneakers/flip-flops/ shorts/t-shirts (no high heeled sandals, no short shorts, see thru shirts or midriff shirts - where your tummy is showing)
-  Outfit for each day, plus a spare including socks/undies. Pajamas.
-  Toothbrush, toothpaste, soap / shower gel, deodorant, hairbrush, necessary toiletries
-  Camera /batteries or disposable camera (please write their name on it) - Totally optional.
-  Insect Repellent/Sunscreen (spray kind best - important for EACH child to bring their own can)
-  Sunglasses / Hat - optional, but highly recommended
-  4 Towels (2 for showers and 2 for swimming) Please put their name on them.
-  2 Washcloths or bath sponge/pouf
-  Garbage bag for soiled and/or wet cloths
-  Sleeping bag or XL twin sheets, blanket and pillow. Can get chilled at night with AC running.
-  SMALL stuffed animal - optional (even our counselors bring theirs)
-  \$5 for snack shack (there is no need to send more than this amount as the kids are provided snack and drinks throughout the day)
-  Most importantly, . . An Open Heart to allow God to work within you during this time away.
-  And . . A positive attitude, A servant's heart, A willingness to meet new friends and learn new things!

Remember . . . Be Flexible - Be open to change!

What NOT to bring to camp...

-  CELL PHONES AND VIDEO GAME DEVICES
-  RADIOS, IPODS, CD PLAYERS, PORTABLE DVD PLAYER
-  WATER GUNS, TOYS and EXCESSIVE AMOUNTS OF CANDY

-  Please write names on their belongings such as disposable cameras, sunscreen, insect repellent, toiletries and towels.
-  Suggestion for littles, put each days clothes in separate Ziploc bag and they can put back in when done and toss into their dirty clothes bag.
-  Campers - Space is limited and there are no shelves for your personal items. Please pack as conservatively as possible.
-  Remember you are responsible for carrying your suitcase and keeping up with your belongings.
