Kids Camp is great time for kids to unwind and unplug!!! We are meeting/making new friends, building relationships, strengthening our relationship with God or starting a relationship with Him.

- ⇒ *Please make sure that **your child is okay staying away from home before sending** them to camp. We want them to have a great camp experience.*
- ⇒ *Once we have reached our number of openings, we cannot add any more spots. Open spots are limited, so if your child is going, please get camp forms and deposit **turned into Kim Watts as soon as possible to secure your spot.***
- ⇒ *Registration forms and camper checklist are available from Kim Watts, in basket outside Kim's office, at the Information Center and church website. (www.oakleafbaptist.org).*
- ⇒ *You can visit lakeswancamp.org, if you would like to see what the camp looks like.*
- ⇒ *We arrive for lunch on Sunday 9 July and leave after breakfast on Thursday 13 July*

Costs and Registration - Camp Cost \$230 (can be paid in full or payments. Suggested schedule below)

- ⇒ *Camp forms must be turned in with initial deposit of \$30.*
- ⇒ *Forms have to be notarized and we have notaries at OBC that can notarize the forms.*
- ⇒ ***First Payment (\$50) is due March 15.***
- ⇒ ***Next payment (\$50) is due April 12***
- ⇒ ***Next payment (\$50) is due May 10***
- ⇒ ***Final payment (\$50) is due June 21***
- ⇒ ***Camp must be paid for by June 21, 2023 as our final payment is due to Lake Swan***
- ⇒ *If you need assistance with camp costs, please let me know. We don't want that to prevent your child from attending and all information is confidential*

OBC Kids Camp Details

- ⇒ *The kids are typically divided by grade/age. This may vary depending on total number of kids and the age/grade breakdown. The boys and girls have separate cabins with a 1-2 counselors assigned to each cabin.*
- ⇒ *Kids will get their cabin assignments enroute to camp and find out who their counselors are.*
- ⇒ *Transportation to/from camp is via school bus.*
- ⇒ *We have busy schedule each day filled with Bible fun, missions, games and other activities like tubing, canoeing, swimming, archery, human foosball, mini golf and much more.*
- ⇒ *Life vests are required to be worn during tubing and canoeing. An adult in the canoe with the campers.*
- ⇒ *A swim test is done on Day 1 for each camper by the camp lifeguards. If the camper isn't a good swimmer, they will get a red wrist band to wear anytime they are in the water and must have lifejacket on.*
- ⇒ *Lifeguards / counselors are in the water with the kids at all times. A counselor is either on the boat with campers when tubing or at the dock.*
- ⇒ *We are the only swimmers/tubers in the lake at our designated swim time.*
- ⇒ *A private Facebook group is set up for camp parents and counselors only. This is one of the ways we will communicate when we arrive and depart camp as well as text messages via our church system. Pictures are also posted here for parents to see what's going on during the week. More info will come as we dates get closer.*
- ⇒ *Kids will call home one time while we are at camp and you will be notified which night that is.*
- ⇒ *There is a talent night, so if your campers want to participate, they can start working on what they want to do. If music is required, they must let Mrs. Kim know at least 3 weeks prior to camp so we have time to download the correct version of the song.*
- ⇒ *A parent and camper meeting will be held 1-2 weeks before we leave for camp. All campers/ parents need to attend. Final camp details will be given at the time.*
- ⇒ *For our previous campers, please note the cost of camp did go up due to rising costs of food and maintenance of camp. This is the first increase since we started going to Lake Swan 7 yrs. ago.*
- ⇒ *Please make sure you have a camper checklist to ensure your child has everything they need at camp.*
